TABSS Task Order Process

Arranging for work to be conducted under TABSS is an easy and straightforward process. A purchase request (PR) that reflects the services needed is created. The PR is forwarded to the applicable Contracting Officer who will prepare a Task Order Request for Proposal (RFP) and determine whether fair-opportunity exceptions or small-business set-asides should be considered. The RFP is then issued and the BayFirst Team will respond to the solicitation. If selected for award, the BayFirst Team will then begin to provide the needed support, *exceeding expectations along the way*.
